



Updated engine cable rule effective immediately!

All inline turbocharged engines are required to have a cable(s) placed between first and second cylinder through exhaust manifold port area.

Cable must be a minimum of one (1) 3/8" manufactured pendant line with a rating of at least 3000 lb or more with a tag from manufacture that indicates rated load capacity with swaged sockets.

No alterations to cable or cable ends

-OR-

Two (2) 3/8" cables between first and second cylinder through exhaust manifold port area with a minimum of 4 clamps at the splice or crimps with a coupler on each cable.

Cable(s) must circle the entire head/block assembly with a maximum of 4" slack.
